

**NOTICE OF CONTINUED PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
THE DIRECT IRRIGATION WITHDRAWAL POLICY OF
THE APPOMATTOX RIVER WATER AUTHORITY**

Notice is hereby given that the Appomattox River Water Authority (the "Authority") will hold a CONTINUED public hearing on amendments to its current policy (the "Policy") pertaining to direct withdrawals of raw water from Lake Chesdin for irrigation purposes ("Direct Irrigation Withdrawals"). Lake Chesdin is the 3,100-acre reservoir located on the Appomattox River on the Chesterfield County and Dinwiddie County line that provides a drinking water supply to the Cities of Colonial Heights and Petersburg and the Counties of Chesterfield, Dinwiddie and Prince George. The principal proposed amendments to the Policy will (i) allow each current holder of a license to make Direct Irrigation Withdrawals to apply for and execute a renewed license agreement with the Authority and continue to make Direct Irrigation Withdrawals for a term to end October 31, 2028, (ii) lift the moratorium on new licenses for the owners of parcels fronting Lake Chesdin, and (iii) provide that the fee for a renewed or new license agreement will not exceed \$675.00. The Authority proposes to make additional minor and conforming amendments to the Policy. The Authority invites comments from the public on whether the proposed amendments to the Policy further the public purposes for which the Authority was created, including the conservation, protection, and beneficial utilization of the water in Lake Chesdin to ensure the public welfare, safety, and health and the sustained use of the reservoir as a source of drinking water. The meeting, which may be continued or adjourned, will be held at 2:30 p.m. on Wednesday, January 16, 2019, before the Authority Board in the board room located at 21300 Chesdin Road, South Chesterfield, VA, 23803. Any person interested may appear at the meeting and present his or her views. Information regarding the proposed amendments to the Policy are posted on the Authority's website (arwava.org) and is on file and is open for inspection at the Authority's office at 21300 Chesdin Road, S. Chesterfield, Virginia, during business hours.
