

MAINTENANCE MECHANIC

The Appomattox River Water Authority is accepting applications to fill a Maintenance Mechanic position. This position will work under the general supervision of the Maintenance Supervisor. Applicants must have at the minimum a high school diploma or GED, experience in the activities, and possess mechanical aptitude. The Maintenance Mechanic will perform senior level skilled work in maintenance, repair and installation of water treatment plant equipment (pumps, valves, motors, drives, pressure regulators, electrical power equipment, electrical controls, HVAC). Perform mechanical and electrical troubleshooting/problem diagnosis and building and grounds maintenance as needed. The successful candidate must be willing to accept assignments based on needs of the Authority. Equipment operation and maintenance in an industrial environment is a plus. Pre-employment drug screen & random drug testing thereafter, DMV check, and criminal background check are required.
